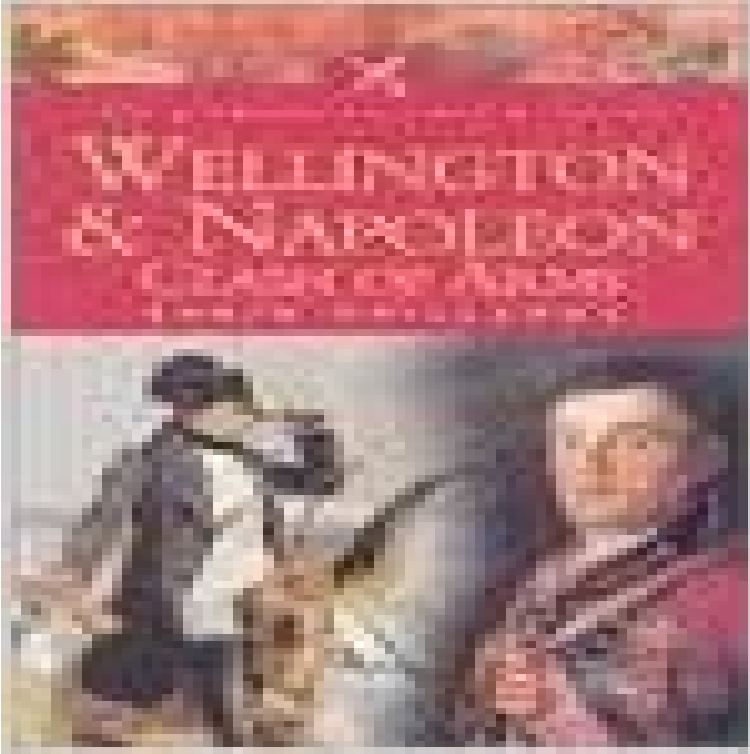


Wellington and Napoleon: Clash of Arms

The opposing armies, like their commanders, were not at all similar. Napoleons were large conscript armies, living off the land and led by marshals who rose by merit. Wellingtons was a smaller, volunteer force, ruled by the lash though paid, and his officers were those the government chose to send. I hope, he said once, the enemy trembles as I do when they read their names. It was the British infantryman who made the difference. It all depends on that article whether we do the business or not. Give me enough and I am sure. Wellington knew that the thin red line, well handled and well placed, would never give ground but would destroy the French columns before they could close with the bayonet. Napoleon never learned to counter Wellingtons infantry, and at the great climax at Waterloo it cost him dear. Even so, the battle was so near-run that but for luck and the Prussians, history might have been quite different.
