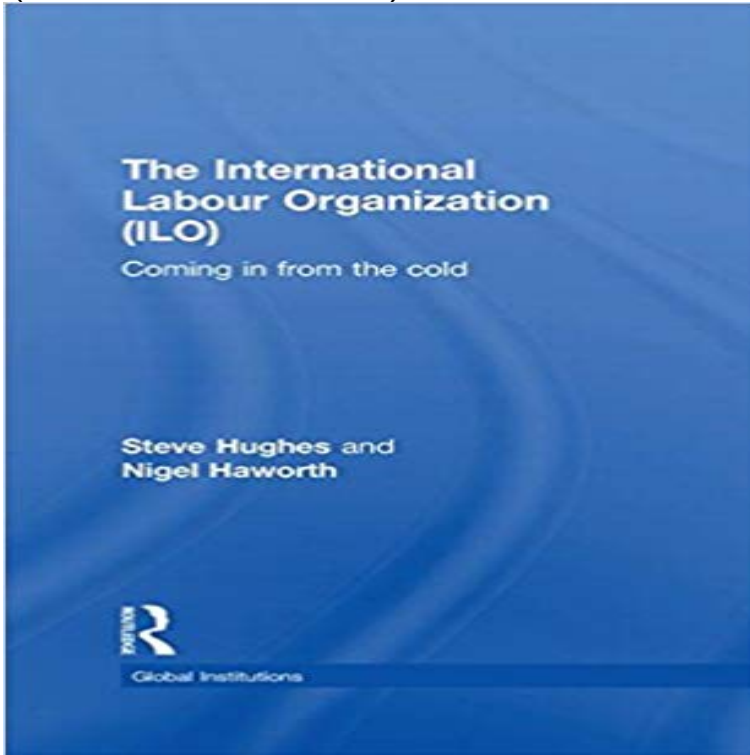


International Labour Organization (ILO): Coming in from the Cold (Global Institutions)
