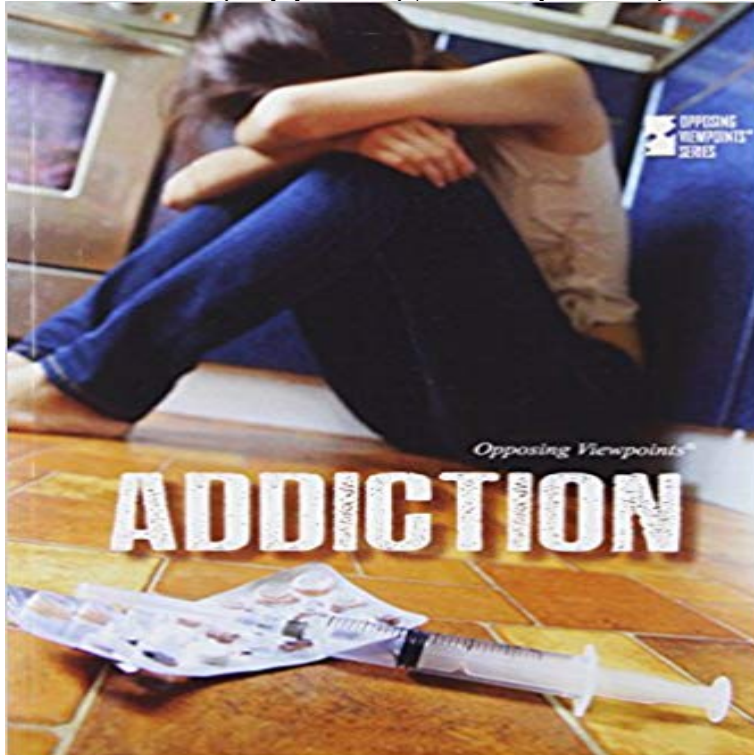


## Addiction (Opposing Viewpoints)
