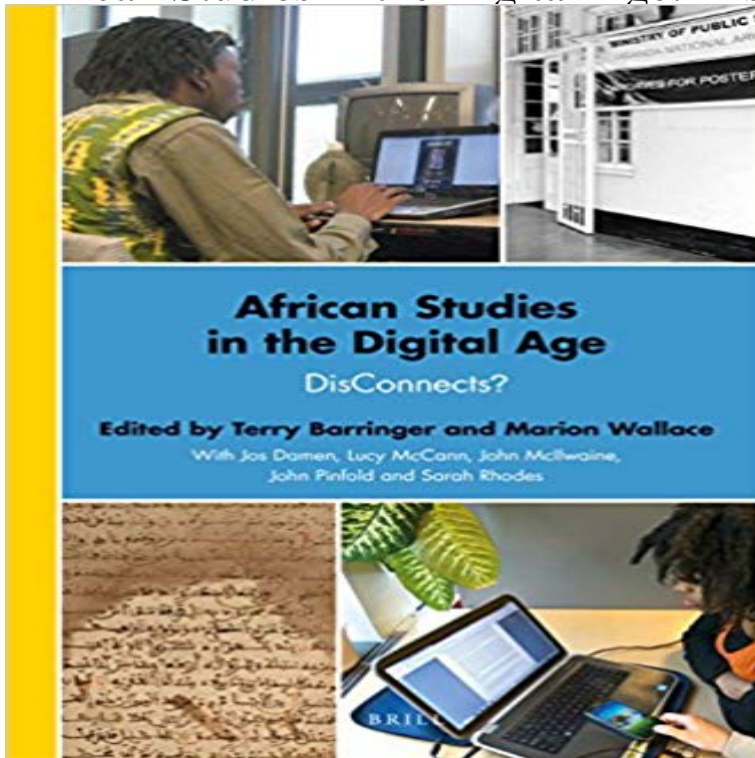


African Studies in the Digital Age: Disconnects?
