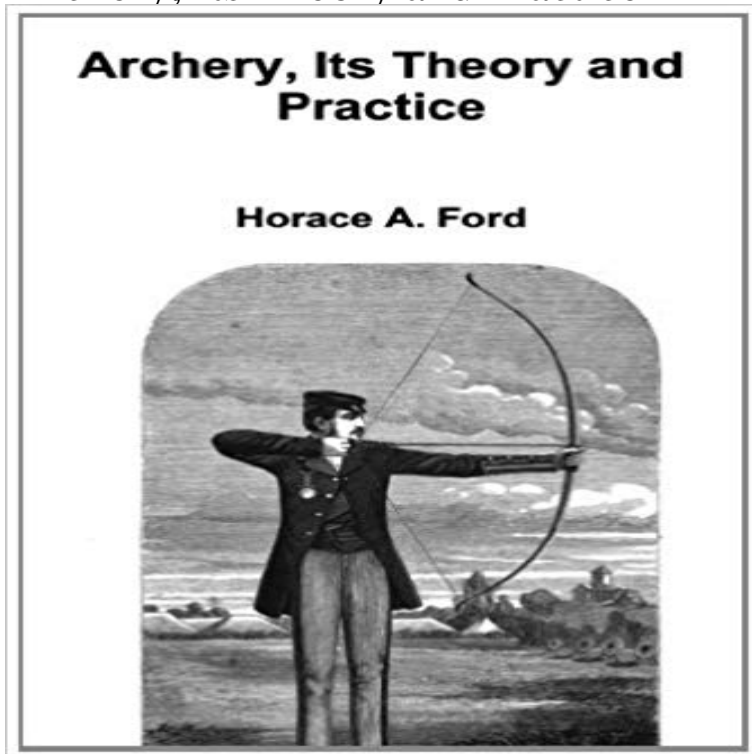


Archery, Its Theory and Practice
