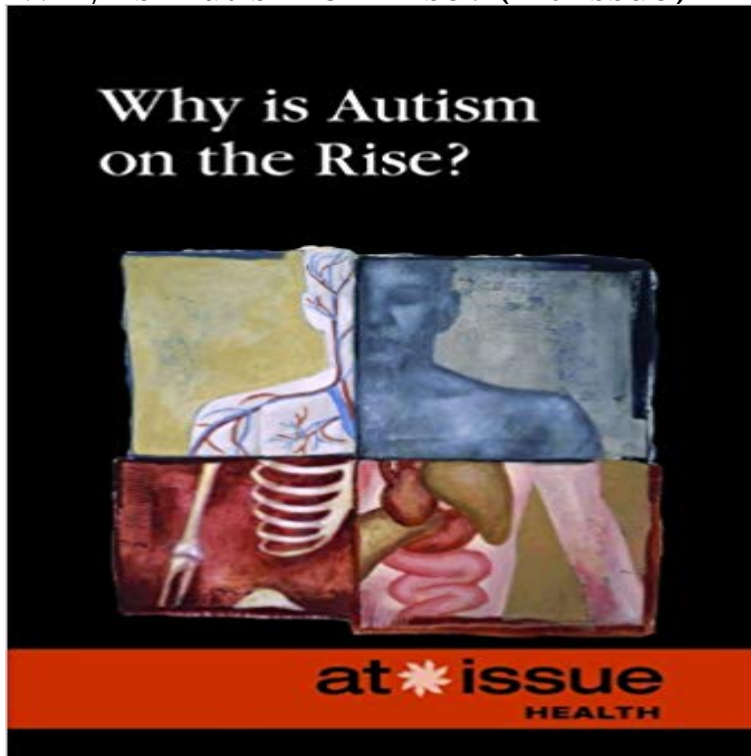


Why Is Autism on Rise? (At Issue)
