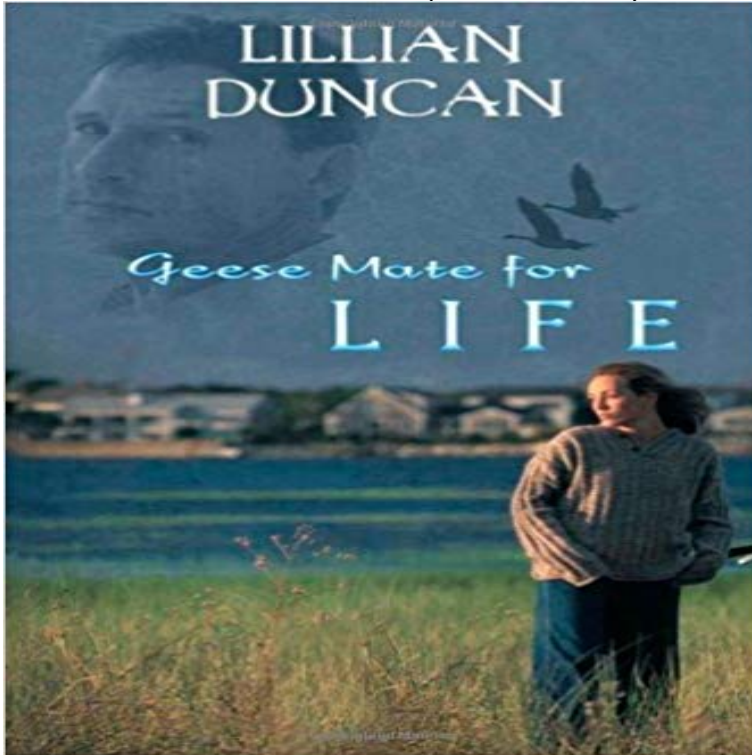


Geese Mate For Life (Volume 1)
