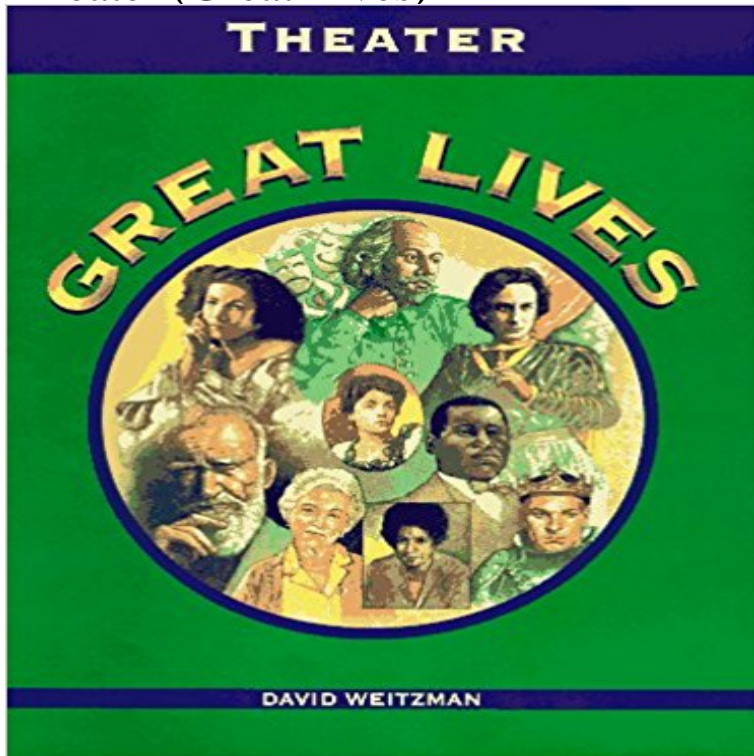


Theater (Great Lives)
