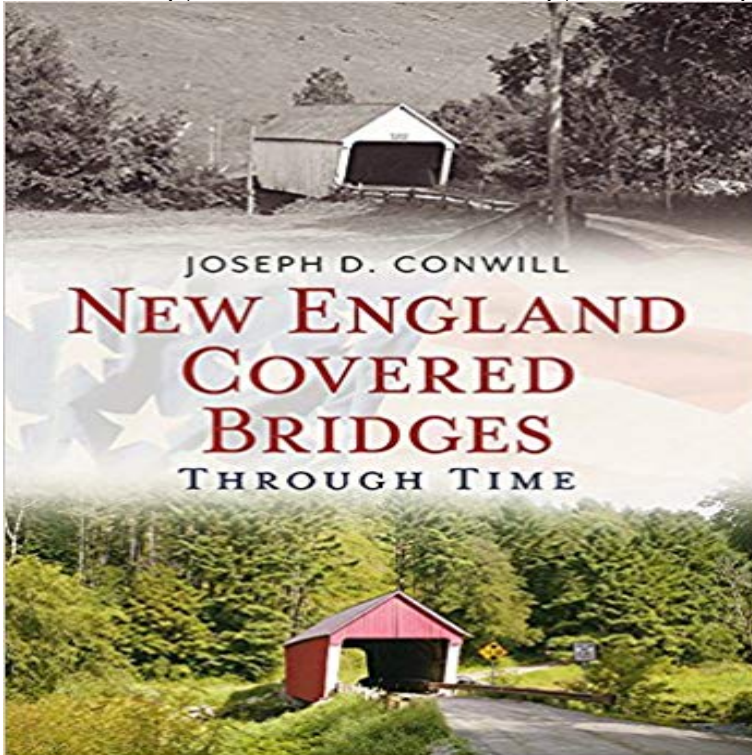


## New England Covered Bridges Through Time (America Through Time)
