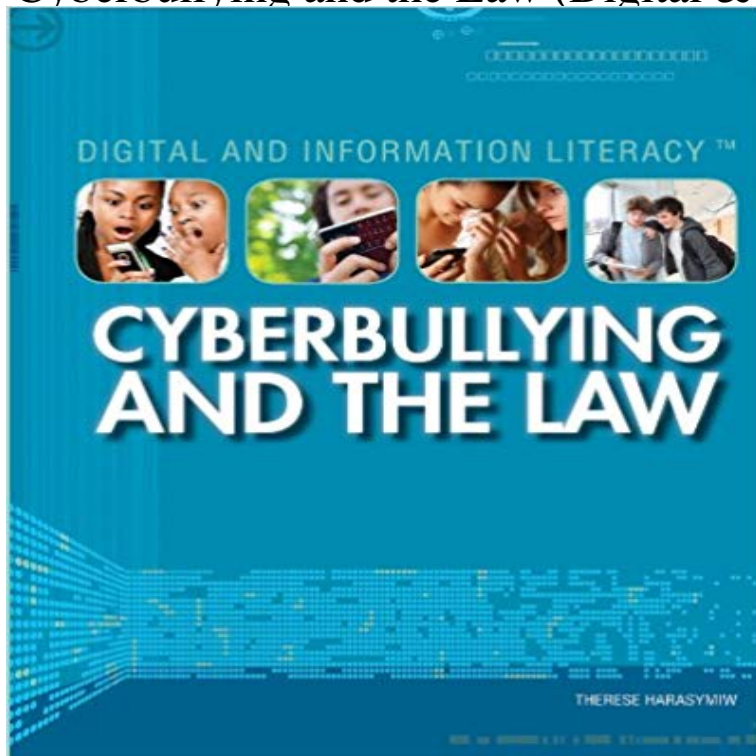


Cyberbullying and the Law (Digital & Information Literacy (Library))
