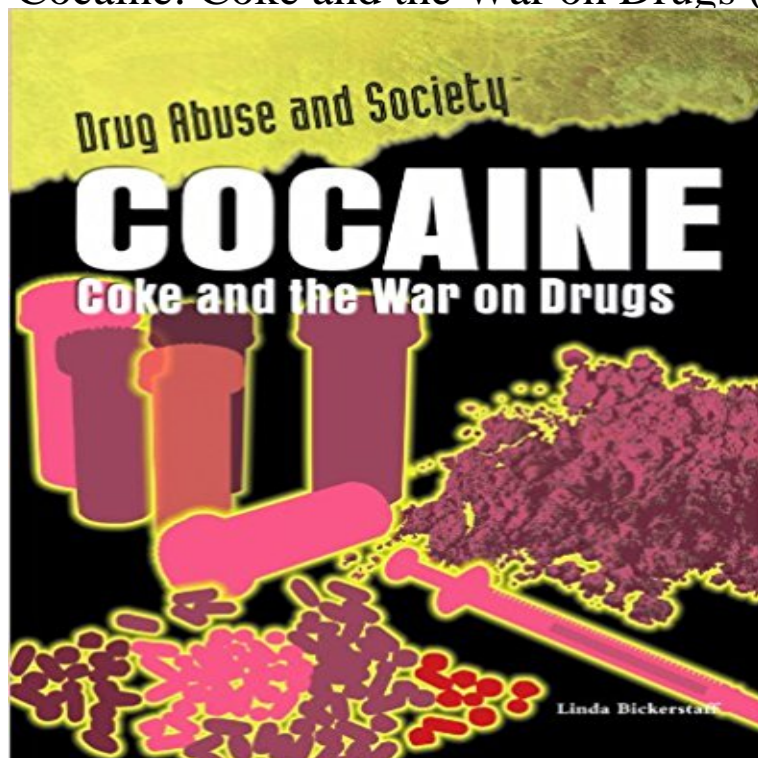


Cocaine: Coke and the War on Drugs (Drug Abuse and Society)
