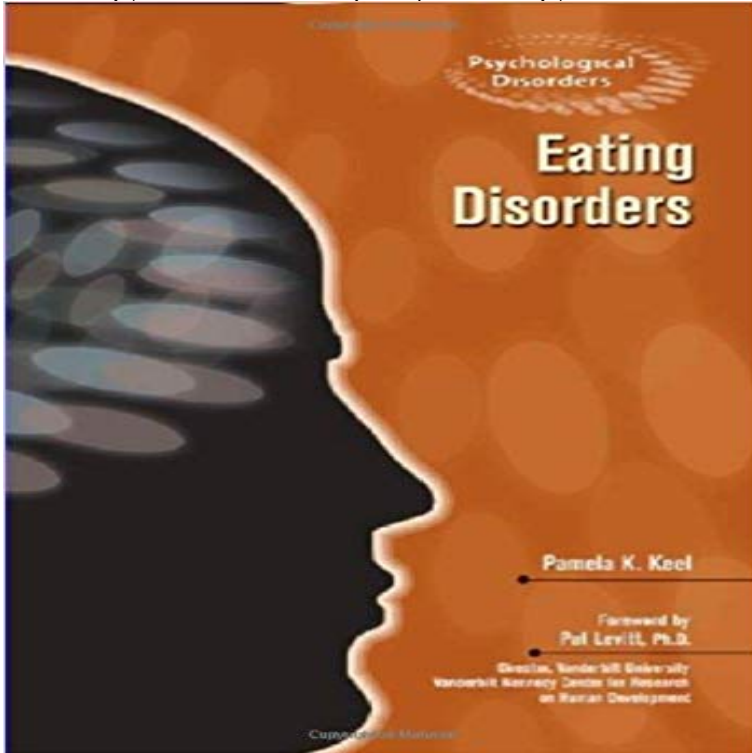


Eating Disorders (Psychological Disorders)
