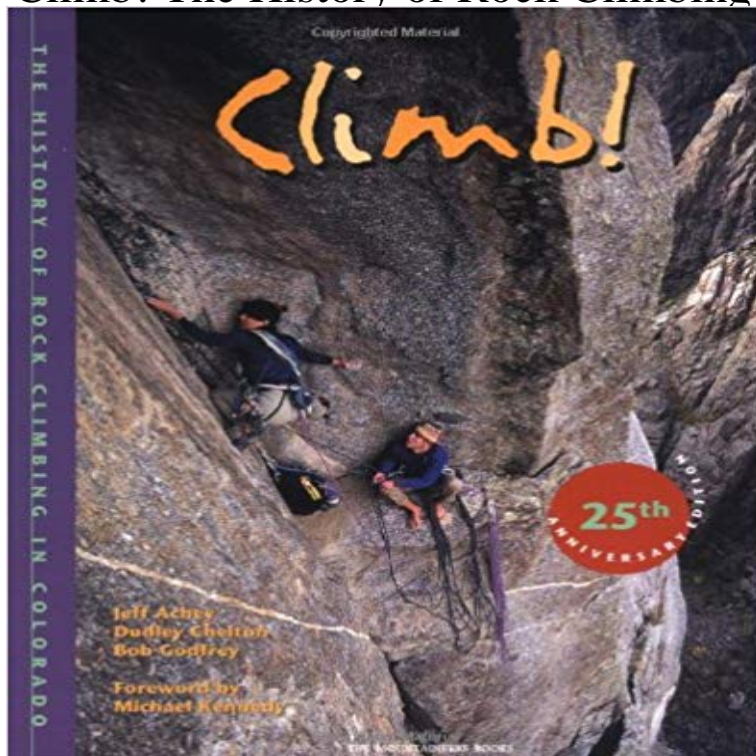


## Climb! The History of Rock Climbing in Colorado
