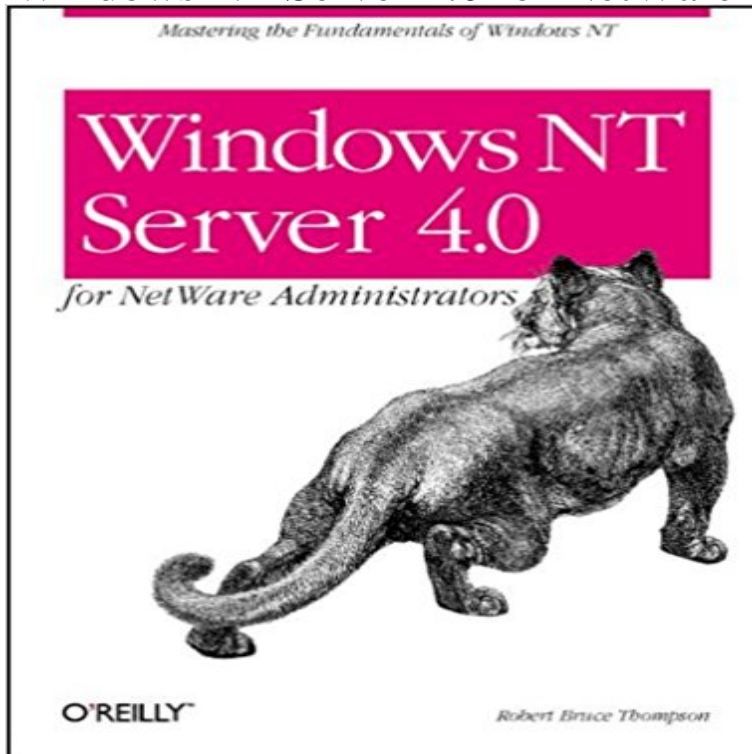


# Windows NT Server 4.0 for NetWare Administrators
