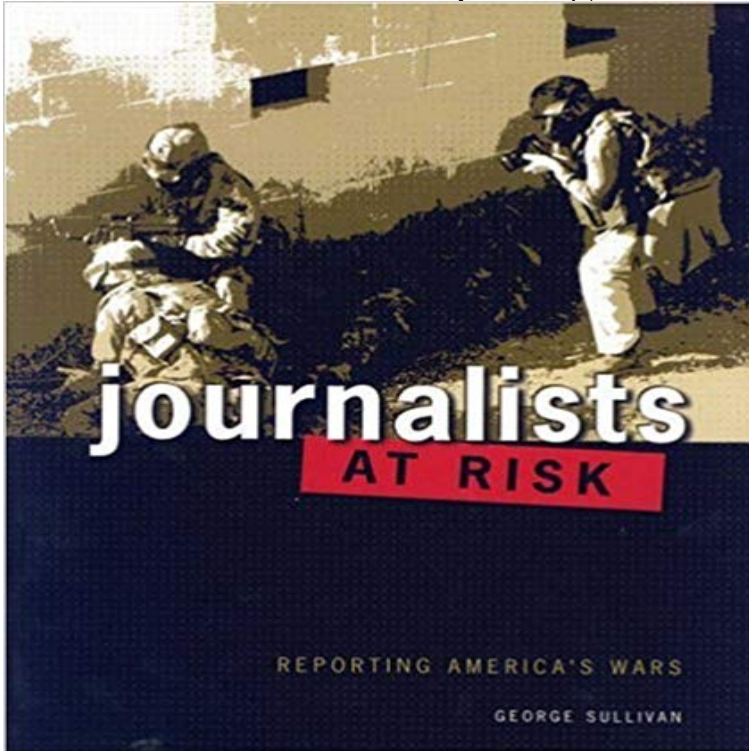


Journalists At Risk: Reporting Americas Wars (Peoples History)
