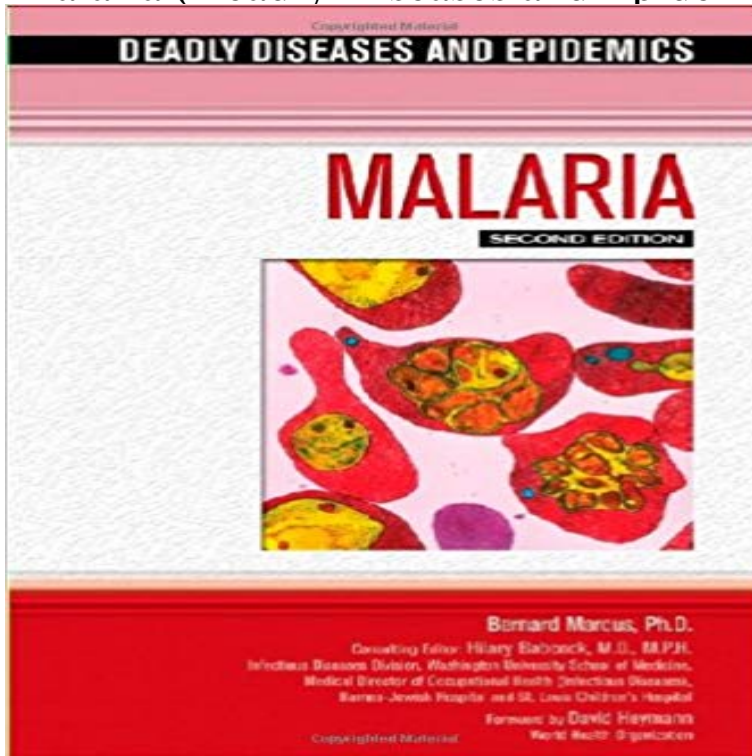


Malaria (Deadly Diseases and Epidemics)
