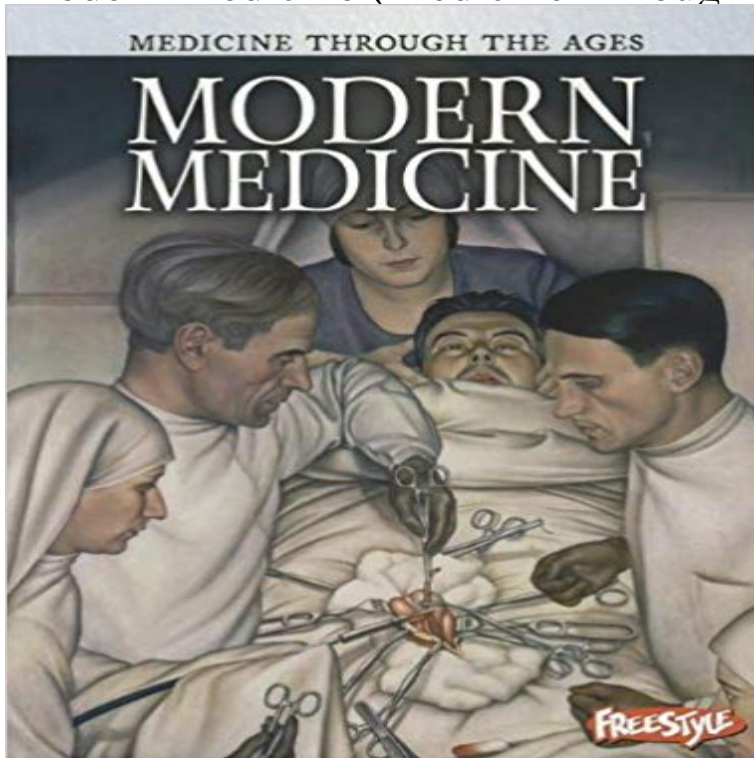


Modern Medicine (Medicine Through the Ages)
