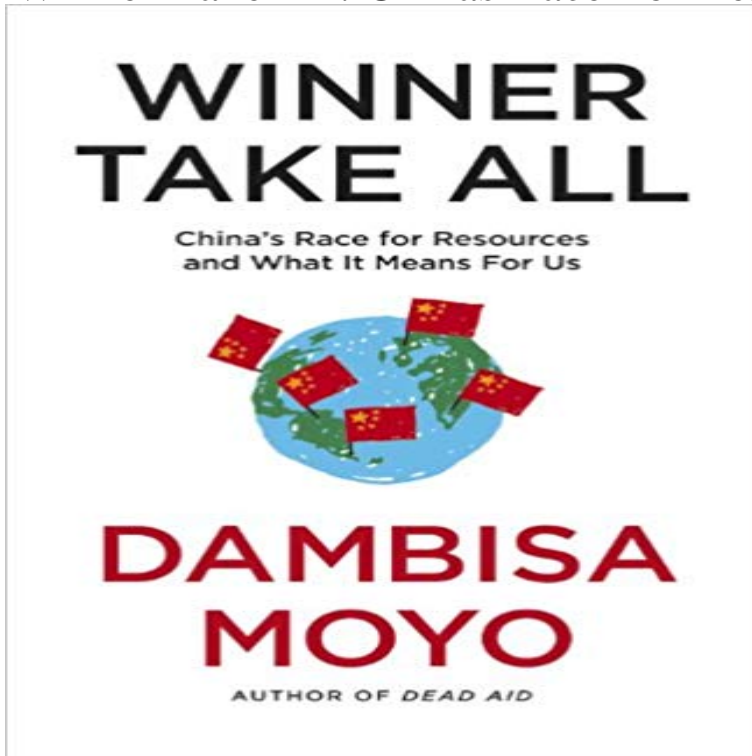


Winner Take All: Chinas Race For Resources and What It Means For Us
