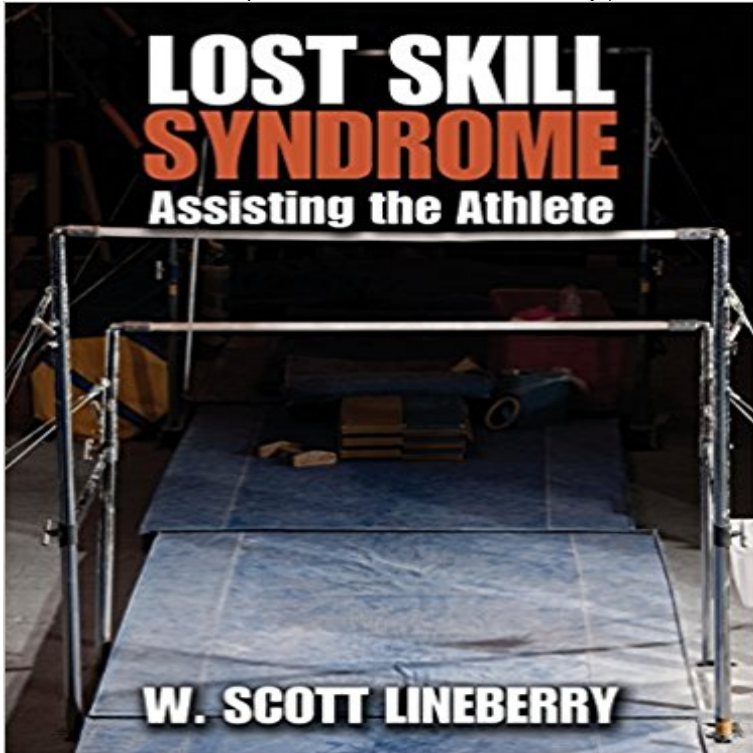


Lost Skill Syndrome: Assisting the Athlete
