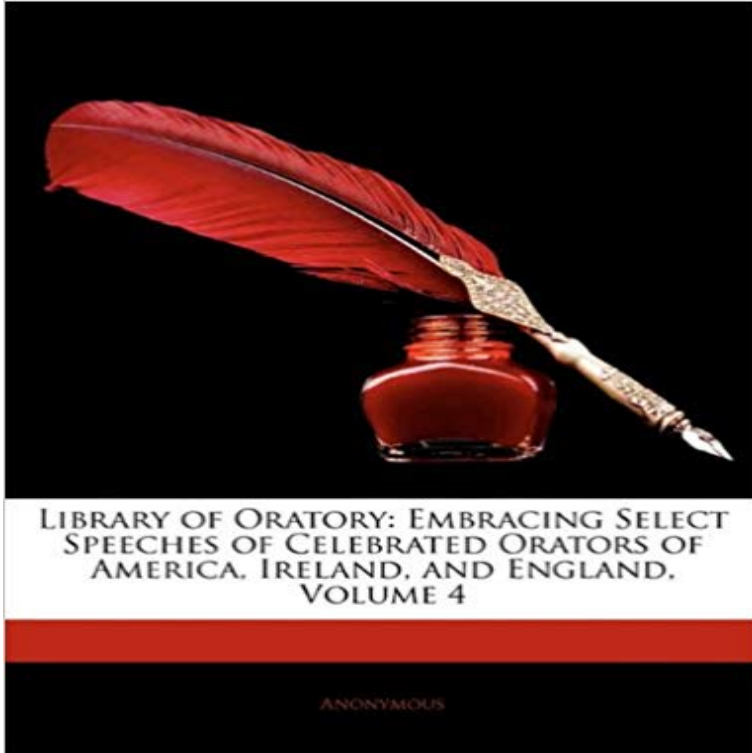


# Library of Oratory: Embracing Select Speeches of Celebrated Orators of America, Ireland, and England, Volume 4
