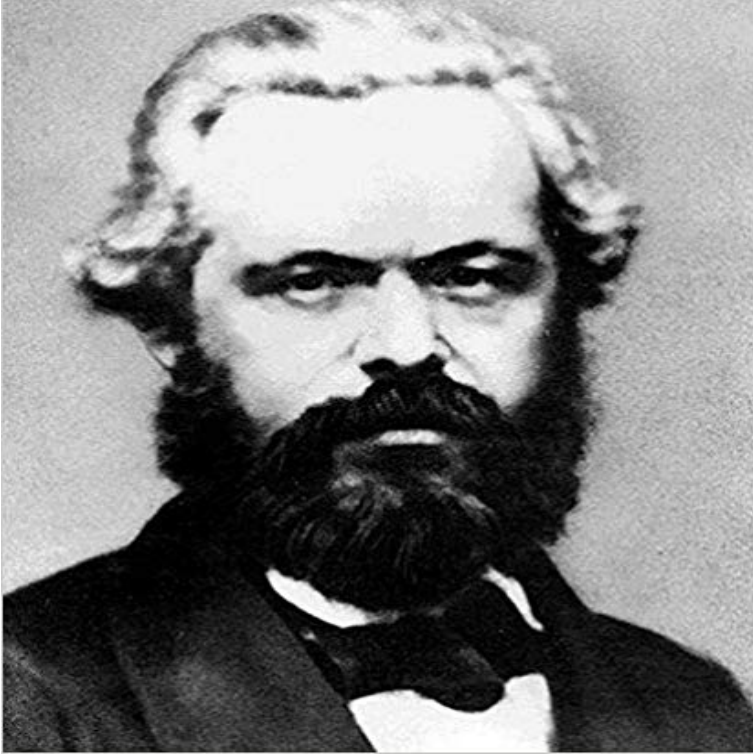


On the Question of Free Trade (Illustrated)

On January 9, 1848, Marx spoke before the Democratic Association of Brussels about free trade. Using the theory of class struggle, Marx reviewed the significance of free trade. Examining root causes of free trade in the publication of the title, Marx claimed that was the time of the Brussels Congress, the time when Marx prepared the speech in question. While recognizing that protection may still, under certain circumstances, for instance in the Germany of 1847, be of advantage to the manufacturing capitalists; while proving that that Free Trade was not the panacea for all the evils under which the working class suffered, and might even aggravate them; he pronounces, ultimately and on principle, in favor of Free Trade.

Marx also pointed out that free trade will accelerate his revolution as in short, productive forces expanding to such a degree that they rebel, as against unbearable fetters, against the social institutions under which they are put in motion; the only possible solution: a social revolution, freeing the social productive forces from the fetters of an antiquated social order, and the actual producers, the great mass of the people, from wage slavery. And because Free Trade is the natural, the normal atmosphere for this historical evolution, the economic medium in which the conditions for the inevitable social revolution will be the soonest created -- for this reason, and for this alone, did Marx declare in favor of Free Trade. It appears that Marx gave us a right conclusion with a wrong reasoning and a wrong trade framework. Communist Party of China is royally practicing Marx's free trade theory today that has created the
