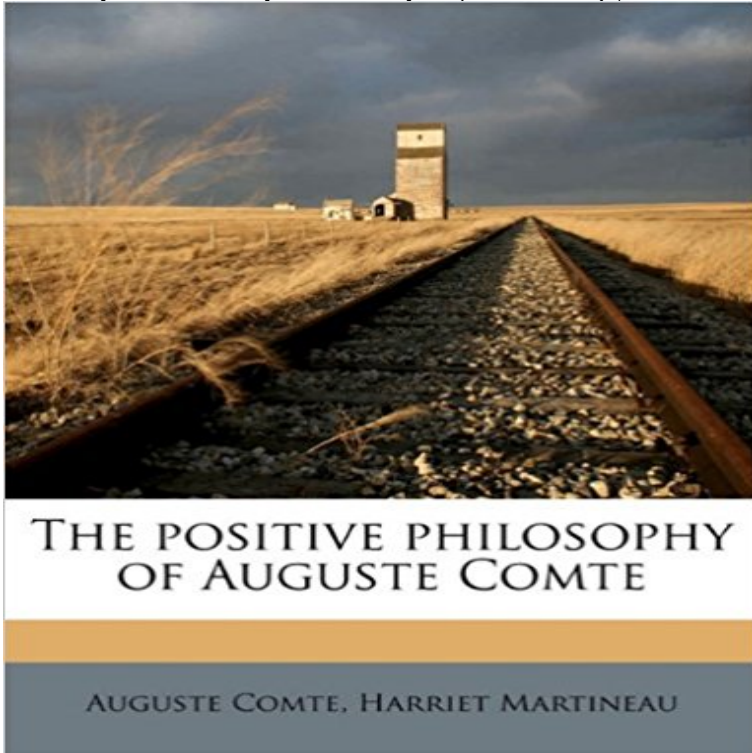


The positive philosophy of Auguste Comte
