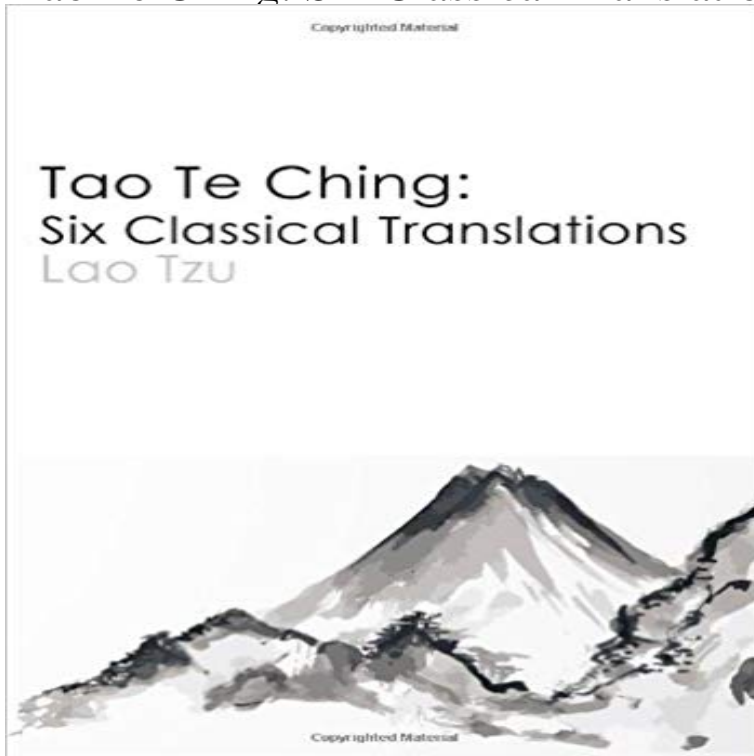


## Tao Te Ching: Six Classical Translations
