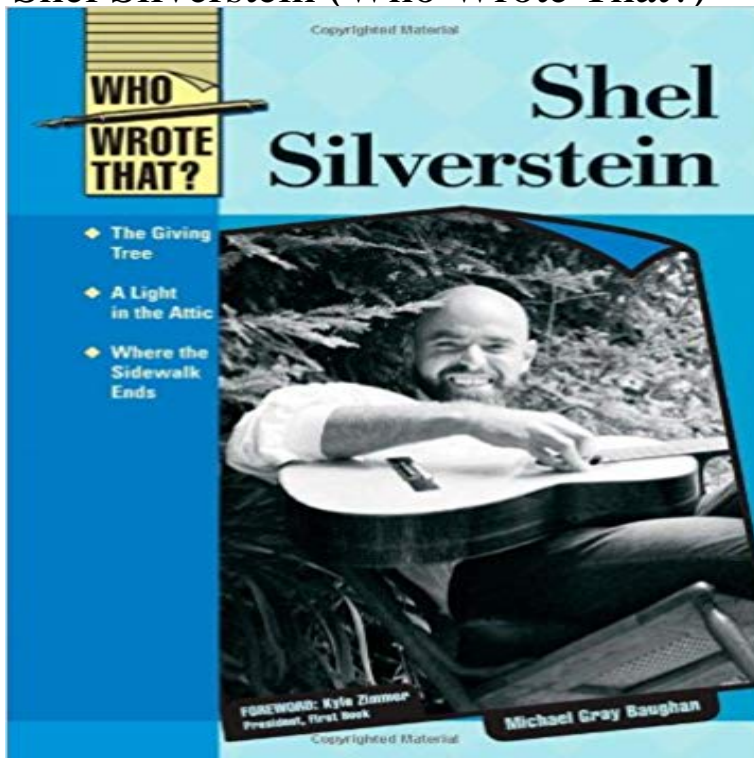


Shel Silverstein (Who Wrote That?)
