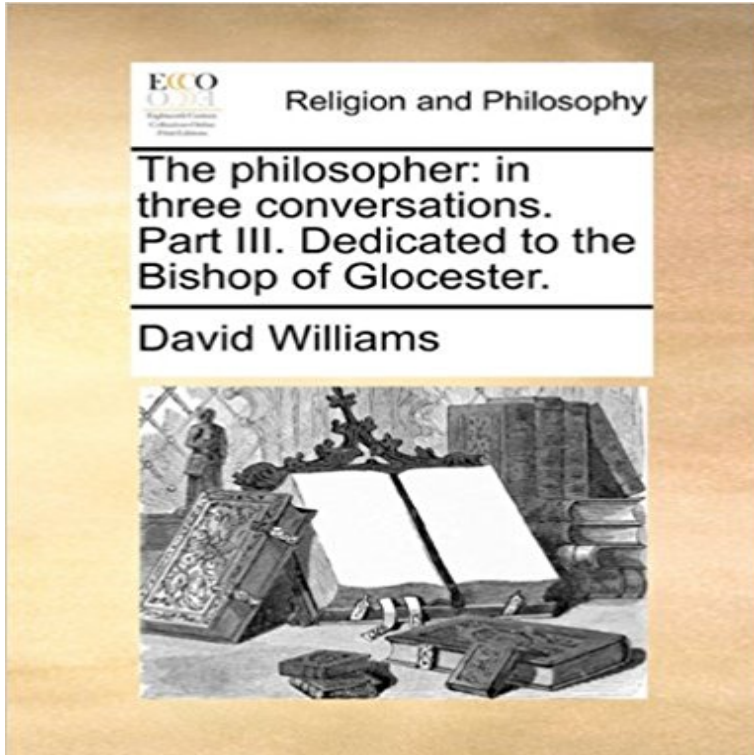


## The philosopher: in three conversations. Part III. Dedicated to the Bishop of Gloucester.
