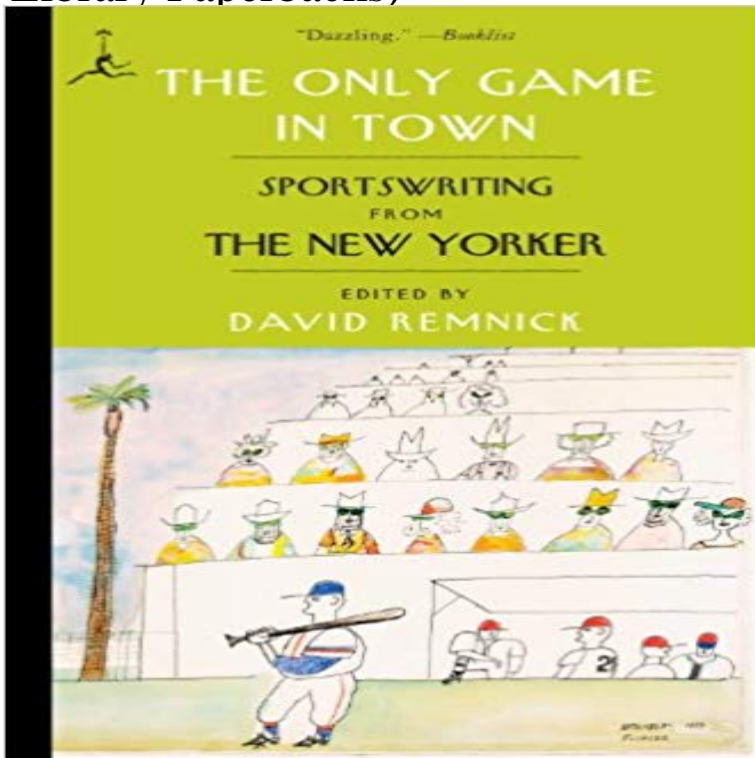


# The Only Game in Town: Sportswriting from The New Yorker (Modern Library Paperbacks)
