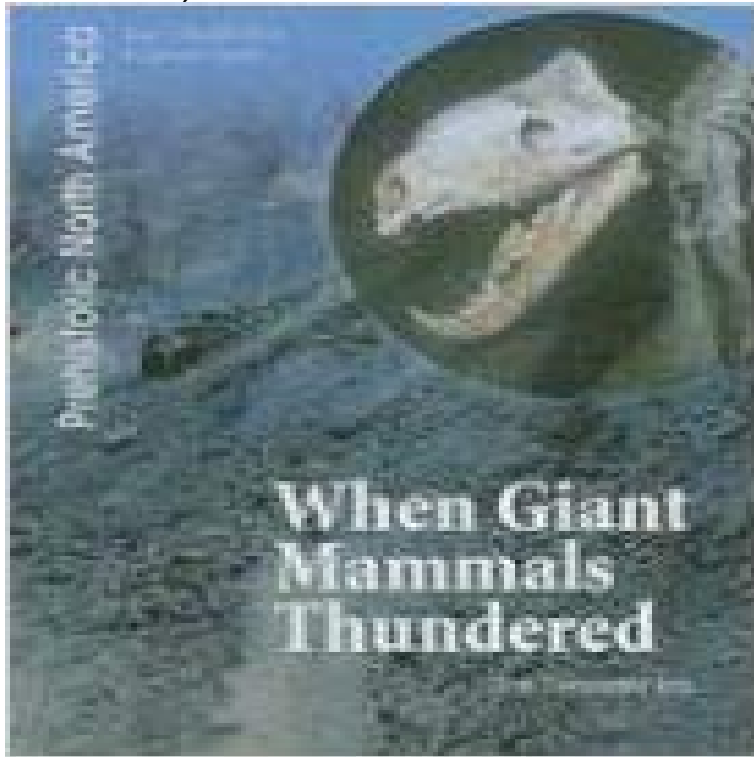


When Giant Mammals Thundered: The Cenozoic Era (Prehistoric North America)
