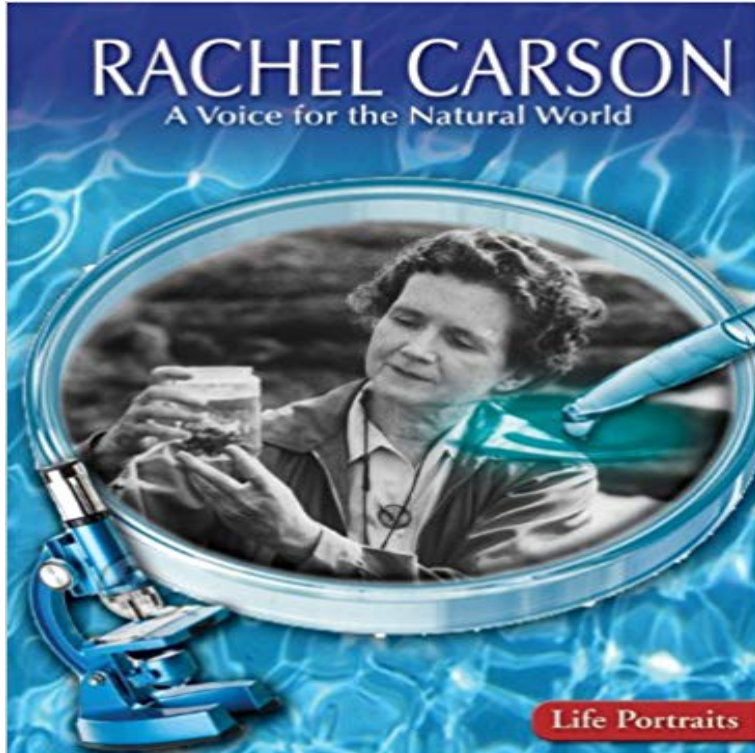


Rachel Carson: A Voice for the Natural World (Life Portraits)
