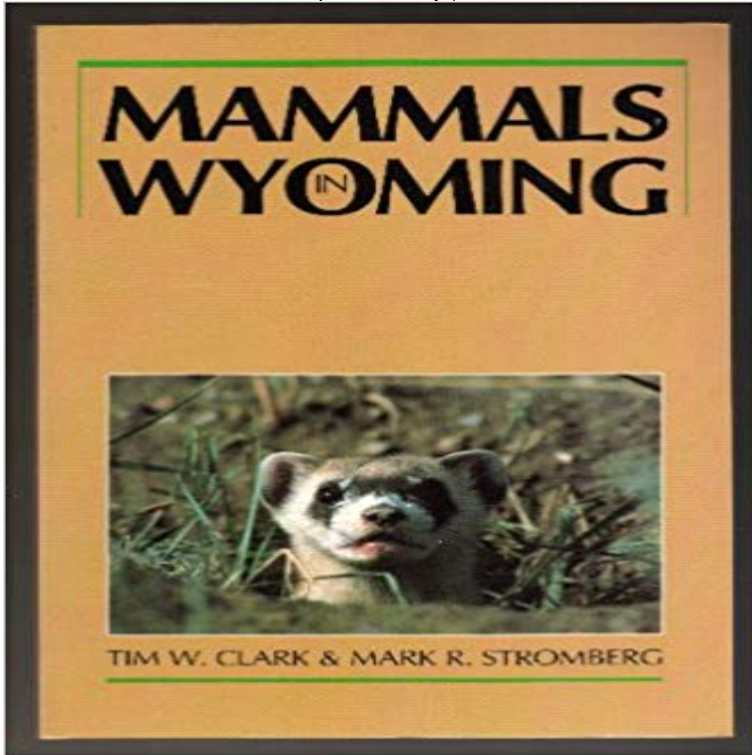


Mammals in Wyoming
